Crystal Robinson joined the Siragusa Family Foundation as the Program Officer in 2017. The Siragusa Family Foundation was created in 1950 by Ross D. Siragusa, founder of Admiral Corporation. Today, it is governed by third and fourth generation family members. Annually, the foundation awards approximately \$1.2 million to over 100 organizations. Crystal oversees grantmaking in the foundation's primary giving areas of arts learning, education and health. Previously, she served as Assistant Director at the Axelson Center for Nonprofit Management at North Park University. She has more than 10 years of nonprofit experience. Prior to North Park University, Crystal was the Development Associate at Horizons for Youth and Development Director at Our Lady of Tepeyac High School. Her first nonprofit job was as a phonathon caller at Dominican University, where she earned a Bachelor of Arts degree. Crystal also has a Master of Nonprofit Administration degree from North Park University. She received her Certified Nonprofit Professional (CNP) credential from the Nonprofit Leadership Alliance in 2014. Crystal served as a board member with AFP Chicago from 2016-2017.
