She began her career in the performing arts as a professional ballet dancer and educator. Since transitioning into arts administration twelve years ago, her experiences have spanned major gift and annual fundraising, board relations, special event management, marketing and sales, and organizational culture leadership.

In her eight seasons with the Harris, she has led growth in every area of the Theater's contributed income, including increasing the donor base by 40%, establishing a planned giving society, directing fundraising events grossing more than \$3 million, and formalizing the Theater's sponsorship program.
