Goverenment Relations Update

FEDERAL

The "Fiscal Cliff:" The American Taxpayer Relief Act of 2012, signed into law January 2, applies in the section relevant to most nonprofits (101c) a federal estate tax of 40 percent to estates in excess of \$5 million (\$5, 120,000 in 2013, adjusted for inflation) for individuals and in excess of %10 million for couples. Representatives of nonprofit associations had come to Washington to advocate for maintaining estate tax levels as well as charitable deduction allowances...<u>read more</u>.

STATE

New Laws Effective January 1, 2013: This year, 150 different provisions went into effect in Illinois on New Year's Day, covering a variety of subject areas. Among those included is the "Skin" tax, an annual surcharge of \$3 per person admitted to a "live adult entertainment facility" that serves or permits the consumption of alcohol on its premises, which can be collected from customers on admission...<u>read more</u>.
