Because of the number of applications submitted, it is not possible to accept late nominations. Nominators must be a current AFP Chicago chapter member. If they are not a member, the nomination must be endorsed by a current AFP Chicago chapter member.

#### Presentation of Awards

The honorees selected will receive their awards at the 38<sup>th</sup> Annual Philanthropy Awards Luncheon May 9, 2014. Honorees will be notified of their selection by December 10, 2013. Honorees <u>must</u> be present to receive awards. AFP Philanthropy Awards are not bestowed posthumously.
