Peer Mentoring Match Qualifications and Expectations

Protégé:

- Current member of AFP Chicago
- Have 12 months (one year) to five years of development experience; protégé applicants with more than five years of experience may also apply for a limited number of slots, depending on cohort capacity and mentor availability
- Commit to participate for one full year (12 months)
- Attend the cohort kick-off
- Commit to being responsible for communicating goals to the mentor
- Meet with or call the assigned mentor regularly as mutually agreed-upon (at least monthly), and honor those scheduled commitments
- Commit to keeping the Peer Mentoring Committee Liaison informed on meetings with the mentor
- Complete assignments as agreed with the mentor
- Complete program evaluations as requested

Mentor:

- Current member of AFP Chicago
- Have a minimum of five years of development experience
- Commit to participate for one full year (12 months)
- Attend the cohort kick-off
- Commit to assist the assigned protégé in accomplishing agreed-upon goals
- Willingness to share information and networks with the protégé
- Meet or speak with the protégé regularly as mutually agreed-upon (at least monthly), and honor those scheduled commitments
- Complete program evaluations as requested
